WELCOME

Welcome to our worship and fellowship at Covenant Community Church. We are a congregation of the Orthodox Presbyterian Church.

THE LORD'S SUPPER

We look forward to celebrating the Lord's Supper in today's morning worship service.

The Lord's Supper is a meal in which we enjoy communion with God and with His covenant people, the church. If you are a member in good standing of a Bible-believing evangelical church, you are welcome to join with us at the Lord's Table. If you are not formally joined to Christ's church, we ask you to refrain from partaking of the Lord's Supper.

We use both grape juice and wine in the Lord's Supper. The cups of the inner ring of the tray contain grape juice, while the cups of the outer rings contain wine.

If you have any questions concerning the Lord's Supper, or if you desire to join Christ's church, please speak with our pastor or one of the elders (you will notice our elders assist the pastor in serving the Lord's Supper) after our worship service.

Preparing for the Lord's Supper...

“Our Lord Jesus, in the night wherein he was betrayed, instituted the sacrament of his body and blood, called the Lord's Supper, to be observed in his church, unto the end of the world, for the perpetual remembrance of the sacrifice of himself in his death. . . .

“Worthy receivers, outwardly partaking of the visible elements, in this sacrament, do then also, inwardly by faith, really and indeed, yet not carnally and corporally but spiritually, receive, and feed upon, Christ crucified, and all benefits of his death: the body and blood of Christ being then, not corporally or carnally, in, with, or under the bread and wine; yet, as really, but spiritually, present to the faith of believers in that ordinance, as the elements themselves are to their outward senses.”

--Westminster Confession of Faith, Chapter 29, Para. 1a & 7.
