WELCOME to our worship and fellowship at Covenant Community Church. We are a congregation of the Orthodox Presbyterian Church. We are a people grateful for the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, which promises the forgiveness of sins and eternal life to all who trust in Christ alone for salvation.

CHILDREN IN WORSHIP

Young children are welcome to join in our worship. If you anticipate that your child cannot exercise the necessary self-control to remain still, please consider making good use of our training room out of consideration for others—particularly during the preaching of the Word.

EVENING WORSHIP

Our evening worship service is as much a part of regular church life as morning worship, and this pattern is rooted in our understanding of a day set aside by God for worship and rest. This day, called the Lord's day in the New Testament (Christ's day, the day of resurrection) is central to the Christian life. It is our delight to bookend that day with morning and evening services, taking an intermission in between for Christian fellowship and physical rest. This has been the pattern of the Christian church for millenia, and only recently abandoned by American Christians. We would encourage you, if you do not regularly attend evening worship, to make it part of your family's regular pattern of worship. You cannot

find a better and more spiritually rewarding activity than the public worship of God.

SUMMER BREAK

Our weekly calendar ordinarily includes Sunday morning Sunday School at 9:30am and a Wednesday night meeting include a fellowship meal, catechism classes for our children, and a prayer meeting. During the summer we take a break from our Sunday morning classes and meet on Wednesday nights for the prayer only (no fellowship meal or children's classes) at 7:00pm. We plan to return to our regular schedule on August 21st.

CONGREGATIONAL MEETING

You are invited to attend a brief congregational meeting following today's morning worship service. At this meeting, the session will bring a report to the congregation regarding our ongoing pastoral search; if the congregation wishes, after hearing the report, to proceed to call a pastor the session plans to recommend Mr. Jeremiah Mooney for election as a second pastor. If the congregation does elect Mr. Mooney, the final business of our meeting will be to consider and vote on terms of call.

Mr. Mooney has served as our pastoral intern since June 1, 2021, and is a licentiate of our presbytery. Jeremiah and his wife Anna have five children: Emma, Charlotte, James, Margo, and Alice.
